River Walkham - Beat 3 Ward Bridge - Huckworthy 1.9K

Walkham Beat 3 is available to Full members, Associate members and Public Ticket holders at any time during the fishing seasons. Fishing is from the **left bank only** and with fly or artificial lure. The beat begins at the foot of the River Egg about 500 metres below Ward Bridge and ends 1.9 kilometres downstream at Huckworthy Bridge. Fishing from either bridge is prohibited.

The river is largely left to manage itself and provides truly wild fishing for brown trout, sea trout and the occasional salmon. The pioneering fishing writer Major Kenneth Dawson lived at Brook within walking distance of this beat and regularly fished here.

Parking is possible at both ends of the beat with additional space where the road crosses the River Egg - really quite a small stream!

Access from Huckworthy bridge is through the drive of Huckworthy Mill. Please make yourself known to the owners and show permits if requested, Stepping over the bridge wall has been discouraged by barbed wire on the upstream side. At Ward Bridge access is possible by climbing down the upstream side of the bridge and walking through the overflow channel to the downstream path. Please note the fishing is in private hands until past the junction of the River Egg. A small disused hydro electric plant can be seen at this point.
